| Monthly living Expense | Living Expense Approximately £1136 per month included Accommodation fees. Exchange students are responsible for all personal expenses including your accommodation costs. |
| Healthcare | The National Health Service (NHS) provides free hospital treatment, free access to doctors, fixed charges for medicine and fixed charges for dentistry and opticians. Most students can register for a HC1 Certificate which allows them to reclaim the costs for paid-for services. Visa and non-visa nationals studying in the UK on a course of less than six months will need to arrange their own health insurance. Visa and non-visa nationals studying in the UK for more than six months will be asked to pay an Immigration Health surcharge of £470 per year. |
