School Introduction	<p>Seisen University is a Catholic liberal arts university focusing in particular on women's education, located in the central area of Tokyo.</p> <p>From April 2025, we'll have 2 faculties as follows; Faculty of Humanities, Faculty of Global Citizenship Studies. Exchange students are enrolled in one of the faculties; however, they have the liberty of selecting classes across different faculties, following their interdisciplinary study plan.</p> <p>Furthermore, the convenient location of Seisen, in the heart of Tokyo, will facilitate students' enjoyment that Tokyo can offer!</p>

Language Requirement	<p>(1) Students with JLPT N2 or higher: Free to choose any subjects, except those restricted.</p> <p>(2) Students with JLPT N3 level (below N2): Take classes mainly in English or practical subjects (e.g., art, PE) in Japanese.</p> <p>All students register for courses with their instructor.</p> <p>A minimum of 7 subjects must be taken, including Japanese language and other courses.</p>
Scholarship for Exchange Students	<p>【Seisen Reisen-kai Scholarship】</p> <p>◆Offered to one student per partner institution upon recommendation.</p> <p>◆Amount: ¥40,000/month for 10 months (year exchange) or 5 months (semester exchange).</p> <p>◆Not available to students receiving other scholarships of ¥80,000/month or more.</p> <p>* Nomination Procedure</p> <p>Select one student and submit a recommendation letter (PDF) via email.</p> <p>The letter must explain why the student is being recommended.</p> <p>Recipients are expected to actively join international exchange events at Seisen.</p> <p>Please nominate students who will contribute to Seisen's internationalization.</p> <p>Deadline: October 10, 2025 (Spring semester)</p> <p>Late submissions will not be accepted under any circumstances</p>
Accommodation	<p>Seisen University doesn't have official student dormitories. Students' Support	<p>【Academic Advisor & Buddy】</p> <p>Each student is paired with an academic advisor and a buddy student.</p> <p>【SEISEN AMIGAS】</p> <p>Volunteer student group offering cultural activities and friendship opportunities for international students.</p> <p>【Wellness Center】</p> <p>Provides medical consultations, mental health counseling, and support for student well-being.</p> <p>【Career Support Center】</p> <p>Offers part-time job info and career support for students interested in working in Japan.</p> <p>【IT Center】</p> <p>Assists with WiFi access and campus system use.</p>

Facilities	Exchange students have full access to all campus facilities. Seisen is a member of the Campus Members Program, granting students free admission to national museum exhibitions and discounts on special exhibitions.	
Insurance	All international students are strongly advised to obtain overseas travel insurance before coming to Japan. Students staying longer than 3 months must enroll in Japan's National Health Insurance, which covers about 70% of medical expenses.
