ESSENTIAL FEES

Typical Cost	\$AUD
Tuition Per Semester (Flat fee, regardless of study)	\$9,864 (exchange students exempt)
OSHC (Health insurance) Single	\$397 <i>8 months (1 session): \$397</i> <i>15 months (2 sessions): \$768</i>
Student Services and Amenities Fee (SSAF)	\$154 (exchange students exempt)
Living expenses**	\$8,000 – \$12,000
TOTAL	\$18,412 - \$22,412

**Including accommodation, food, entertainment, books, additional internet usage beyond the UOW allocated quota, printing costs and transport. Living expenses will vary according to individual lifestyle.

NOTE: for summer session, the tuition fee is \$4,700
