FORGE New International Student Orientation

All new international students must attend the FORGE International Student Orientation as required by US Government Regulations. This event will help students become acclimated with UCO and provide helpful information for their stay in the United States. The orientation will be held the Saturday before the first week of classes during the Fall and Spring Semesters.



Any medical services that insurance does not cover are subject to additional fees, in addition to textbooks and learning materials that may be required for classes.

Health insurance is required for all visiting students. UCO will charge your student account for insurance coverage. This insurance can be waived if you already have coverage that meets university requirements.

STEPS to FOLLOW

Request Nomination

Contact your home university and request to be nominated as an exchange or visiting student. They will contact UCO to ensure you are eligible.

Apply for Admission

Apply for admission to UCO by visiting our website and submitting all required documents for admission along with your application.

Receive Admission & Immigration Documents

Once accepted, your UCO ID number, DS-2019, and admission documents will be sent to you by post. You must use your DS-2019 document to apply for a J-1 student visa at your local embassy.
