Course Load	The minimum study load for a full-time student at HKBU is 12 credits per semester. This is also to satisfy the immigration laws of the Government of the Hong Kong SAR. Maximum study load per semester: 18 credits.	
Course Offering & Course Registration	Undergraduate Exchange Students can freely choose and enroll in any courses across disciplines (provided that the prerequisite requirements, if any, are met and subject to course availability.) The course pre-registration exercise will be scheduled around mid-July for the Fall semester and mid-November for the Spring semester. Visit the latest Course List. Transcript of Record	Official transcripts in electronic format are generally available about 2 months after the final exams. Students will receive a notification email when the transcripts are available.

A 1	Undergraduate Exchange Students may choose to stay in the Undergraduate Halls or Village CARE on campus. All rooms are double-occupancy and on a first-come-first-served basis. Hall management reserves the right to make the final decision regarding hall assignments. Application details will be sent around mid-July for the Fall semester and mid-November for the Spring semester.		
Accommodation	Postgraduate Exchange Students may be housed in the Dr. Ng Tor Tai International House (NTT) on campus. Application details will be announced to admitted students. Apart from on campus housing, students may choose to live off-campus. For off-campus options, please visit the Off-campus Accommodation Alternatives Section on the Office of Student Affairs webpage and visit Accommodation for more information.		
Student Visa Application	All students must apply for a student visa/permit in order to study in Hong Kong. HKBU International Office will coordinate with the Hong Kong Immigration Department (IMMD) in Hong Kong on the students' behalf. Please note that students do not need to arrange their visas at their local Chinese embassy/consulate. It normally takes the IMMD 8 weeks to process a visa application. Once available, HKBU International Office will collect the student visa and send it to the student. Students will be required to pay HKBU for the visa fee after arriving in Hong Kong.		
Buddies Scheme	Exchange students are paired with Buddy volunteers who share their knowledge of HKBU and Hong Kong, helping newcomers settle in during their first month. In return, the buddies learn about the students' culture and country. This scheme creates a meaningful platform for lifelong friendships and deeper cultural understanding.		
Fees & Payment	Tuition Fees is waived but all students are required to pay an administrative fee of HK\$1,800* to cover costs such as visa application fee and some academic & orientation services.
